Dress Code:

REHEARSALS:

Dress should be acceptable school dress. Students should be mindful of covering the appropriate body parts and underwear should not be seen. Clothing should not contain offensive language or logos and drug and alcohol logos are not permitted. Students may be asked to change clothes if necessary.

CONCERT:

The following attire are considered acceptable for concerts:

Black dress pants or skirt, black dress shoes, white or black dress shirt, and tie.

Solid black dress with sleeves or black jacket.

Denim, t-shirts, and polo shirts are not acceptable for concerts.

If the audience will notice what you are wearing instead of what you are performing, you shouldn't wear it. Please note that WHITE is not the same as cream, ivory, rose, or any other "almost white" color.

**Student dress at all festival activities is a reflection on the individual student, his /her school and music educators, and on the Winooski Valley Music District. Those unable to dress appropriately will be asked to leave the activity and may be subject to dismissal from the Festival.
